Topic: All about Me



How to help your child's learning...

- Using why and how questions about things your child is doing or talking about.
- Practice writing your child's name with them to gain confidence with letter formation.
- Practice recognising, writing and counting the numbers to 10.

Literacy

We will be practicing writing our names and making sure our letters are formed the correct way. We will begin to write CVC words such as pan, tip, mat, cat etc.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will follow the Mathematics Mastery programme.

During maths this term we will be working on:

- Patterns
- Numbers to 10
- Shape (2D and 3D)
- One more and one less
- Addition and Subtraction

Phonics

Children will learn the initial sounds using the Read Write Inc. programme, this will help to support both reading and writing.

Children will be put into groups and will begin to take reading books or papers home from this programme as soon as they begin reading!
