

Year 1 Curriculum Map Summer Term B 2018

Topic

We will be learning about explorers throughout history. Our big question is: How have explorers changed our lives?

Writing

For fiction we will begin by focusing on the story of 'Rumpelstiltskin'. We will be learning the words, rhythm and structure of the text, before moving on to rewriting it with altered characters. Finally we will be writing a five-part story of our own.

Following this we will be learning how to write explanation texts, focussing on how to write to explain processes.

Maths

- Comparing the capacities of containers.
- Learning how to measure volumes.
- Applying knowledge of halves and quarters to describe capacities and volumes.
- Revising – money, 3-D shape, number bonds to 20, time.

Science
