

Literacy

- Write your own story about a child who goes on a steam-train.
- Ask an older member of your family to write a story with lots of mistakes and then you can edit it by adding capital letters and full stops.
- Help an adult make a snack and then write the instructions on how you did it.
- Write a persuasive piece of writing about doing your favourite activity. Remember who your audience is.

Art/Design

- Make your own ship and decorate it.
- Take an everyday item and change it into a magical object. For example take a shoe box, decorate it and turn it into a treasure chest.
- Create a picture that best represents spring and summer. Think about the colours and textures you could use.

Science

- When shopping look at where different fruit and veg are grown around the world.
- Try and plant your own veg. try radishes or spinach.
- Plan what you would place in your suitcase if you were traveling in spring and in summer.
- Research what do animals do in the spring or the summer that is different to the winter or autumn.

Maths

- When out shopping try and help your parent pay using coins.
- Tell the time when you wake up, leave the house to come to school, come back home and are getting ready for bed.
- Find 3D shapes around the house, name them and identify how many faces and edges they have.
- Say any number between 20 and 100 and draw a representation of how many tens and how many ones.
- Play finds the difference. You choose one number and someone else finds another number then find the difference between the two numbers.



Reading

- Read out loud to a member of your family for 5 minutes a day.
- Discuss your reading with a family member every day.
- Order your story into 5 parts.

Topic

- Try and write a travel brochure about going to the moon.
- Look at the world map and plan an expedition around the world. Where would you go? Why would you go there?
- Write a biography about your favourite explorer.
- Plan an expedition to a country that interests you. Think about what mode of transport you would need? What tools will you need to bring with you? Will you need to bring any special equipment? How long will it take?
