Talk for writing: The Three Bears

Following this we will be focusing on non-fiction writing where children will be writing list, labels and captions for the toys they will be making for art. Our poetry focus this half term will be learning rhymes and building vocabulary.

Throughout the half term we will be focussing on the presentation of handwriting specifically letter formation and the correct size of letters.

How to help your child's learning

Reading: Your child will be given a stage for their home reading books. They will bring home a new book each week along with one from their phonics group, which they are expected to read. Please support your child with developing their comprehension by listening to them read and checking that they understand what they have read. Ask as many questions as you can using the 5W's: Who? What? When? Where? Why? Children should be reading with an adult at least 5x per week for minimum of 15mins.

Spelling: Your child will be practicing spellings every day during phonics lessons but they will also take spellings home every Friday to learn for a test the following Friday. It would be great if you could regularly test your child on their spellings at home to set them up for success (make sure to use the phonics sounds).

Maths: It would also be very helpful if you could practise telling the time with your child, number bonds up to 20 and doubling and halving.

Topic and Other Subjects

Our big question is: *Are old toys more fun to play with than new toys?*

History We will be looking at toys throughout history, including the Victorian era and the modern day. We will be looking at our favourite toys and how they have changed over time.

Art This Term Year 1 will be designing and making toys.

Maths

- Number formation
- Adding and subtracting.
 - eg. $2+1=3$
 - $1+2=3$
 - $3-1=2$
 - $3-2=1$
- 2D and 3D shapes.
- Number bonds to 10
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's
- Identifying shapes and patterns.

Science

We will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

We will also be learning how to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
