Literacy

Adventure and Mystery stories

To start off we will be learning the story of The mystery of the Ottoman's chest. The aim this term is continue writing with sophisticated vocabulary and develop independence in writing where less structure is provided to allow the accumulation of their learning to shine through unaided.

Later on in the term we will be writing recounts based on Egyptian culture which is linked to our topic this half term. It push children to be in the mind frame of someone from the past and what that might have been like.

Throughout the half term we will be focusing on using adverbs in the past tense, commas to mark boundaries in sentences and the use of inverted commas to punctuate speech.

Science

This term we will be learning about forces and magnets. We will be looking at scientific theories and how they can be tested. We will be learning about famous scientists who contributed toward the advances we have today. We will learn about magnetism and the special circumstances that allow polarity.

How to help your child's learning

Reading: Your child will be given a stage for their home reading books. They will bring home a new book each week which they are expected to read. We highly recommend visits to the local library to take out books that will help support them in Literacy. Please support your child with developing their comprehension by listening to them read and checking that they understand what they have read. Ask as many questions as you can using the 5W's: Who? What? When? Where? Why? Children should be reading with an adult at least 5x per week for minimum of 15mins.

Spelling: Your child will be practicing spellings periodically throughout the week but they will also take spellings home for a weekly test.

Maths: It will be helpful to children keep on top of their times table, practicing multiplication, addition and subtraction by columnar method.

Topic and Other Subjects

Our big question is: *Were mummies really marvellous?*

History – We will be exploring the exciting topic of Ancient Egypt! One of the most anticipated topics, it is sure to be insightful and enjoyable for year 3.

Art Year 3 will be making use of ITC skills to create colourful pieces of art based on Egypt

Maths

- Deepen understanding of multiplication and division
- Represent and solve multiplication and division problems
- Represent and solve multi-step multiplication and division word problems
- Multiply 2-digit numbers by six and eight (with regrouping)
- Apply a range of strategies to mentally calculate addition
- Apply a range of strategies to mentally calculate subtraction
- Apply addition and subtraction calculation strategies within a context
- Use complementary addition to calculate the difference
- Use commutativity and associativity for mental multiplication
