Literacy

Narrative:

In Literacy we will be looking at the narrative of The Fox and the Raven. Children will be focusing on creating stories with morals. We will continue to build on their previously acquired storytelling skills and really hone in on the editing process.

For our Non-Fiction we will be doing recounts on significant events in the past.

Later in the term we will also be looking at vocabulary building with a poetry focus.

Throughout the half term we will be focusing on using adverbs to show time and place, commas to mark boundaries in sentences and the use of inverted commas to punctuate speech.

Science

This term we will be learning about Rocks. Geology is a big part of what we understand about the world today and children will spend time in learning about the history of the planet and the various minerals in different types of rock and why it is useful for us today.

How to help your child's learning

Reading: Your child will be given a stage for their home reading books. They will bring home a new book each week which they are expected to read. Please support your child with developing their comprehension by listening to them read and checking that they understand what they have read. Ask as many questions as you can using the 5W's: Who? What? When? Where? Why? Children should be reading with an adult at least 5x per week for minimum of 15mins.

Spelling: Your child will be practicing spellings periodically throughout the week but they will also take spellings home every Monday to learn for a test the following Monday. It would be great if you could regularly test your child on their spellings at home to set them up for success.

Maths: It would also be very helpful if you could practise number bonds to 20. In addition mental math is needed for simple mathematical equations. It would also be helpful to use formal written methods.

Topic and Other Subjects

Our big question is: *How have people changed over time, since the Stone Age?*

Geography & History – We will be exploring the topic of the stone-ages. In it will cover what we know from historical finds.

Art Year 3 will be looking at stone-age art as well as various natural environments. They will be developing their skills in sketching.

Maths

- Mentally add / subtract a single digit number to / from a 3-digit number, including regrouping
- Mentally add a multiple of ten to a 3-digit number, including regrouping
- Mentally subtract a multiple of ten from a 3-digit number, including regrouping
- Mentally add / subtract a multiple of 100 to / from a 3-digit number (within 1000)
- Mentally add / subtract two 3-digit numbers with no regrouping
- Use rounding to estimate the answer to a calculation
- Add two 3-digit numbers using column addition
- Subtract 3-digit numbers using column subtraction
- Solve addition and subtraction word problems
- Solve two-step addition and subtraction word problems
