Home/School Prep

There are lots of things that can be done at home to continue children's learning. Your Home/School Prep sheet will give you lots of ideas of various activities that will extend children's learning.

How to help your child's learning

Maths – Throughout the year the children will be practicing their times tables, with the expectation that they will have learnt them all by the end of the year. You should encourage them to practice a different times table each week.

Reading – Children will bring their reading book home every night. Encourage your child to read to you regularly and sign their reading record. Reading books will be changed once a week, however they will also have the opportunity to take a book from our school and class libraries.

Literacy

- This term the children will be writing their own short stories and creating informative/persuasive leaflets
- The children have prepared their own 'Writer's Toolkit' with skills they are going to include in their writing. Please ask your child about their toolkit.
- We will go for a guided London Walk and use this to inspire our writing

Guided Reading

- This term the children will continue reading the novel 'Clockwork' by Philip Pullman

Maths

- Adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominators.
- Adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators
- Decimals Fractions and their equivalents
- Finding fractions of amounts (e.g 2/3 of 300)
- Finding percentages of amounts (45% of 380km)
- Geometry including angles
- Properties of shapes and triangles

Science

In Science, we will be learning about materials and their properties. We will be conducting investigations every week to understand the properties of materials that: conduct heat, dissolve and disappear, change irreversibly and also how to separate different materials
