How to help your child's learning

Maths – Mathematics is available for all students in Year 6 and it is tailored to each individual's needs. Additional work in Maths is available upon request from Miss Oudomvilay. Maths Booster on Wednesday afternoon will start this half term.

Reading – Children will bring their reading book home every night. Encourage your child to read to you regularly and sign their reading record. Reading books will be changed once a week, however they will also have the opportunity to take a book from our school and class libraries.

Home/School Prep

There are lots of things that can be done at home to continue children's learning. Your Home/School Prep sheet will give you lots of ideas of various activities that will extend children's learning.

Literacy

- During our Talk for Writing sessions we will be writing our own story based on ‘The Hobbit, learning to write narratives and discussion texts
- During our Guided Reading sessions we will read The Hobbit by J.R.R.Tolkien.
- We will focus heavily on improving the children's inference skills and developing the depth at which they answer questions.
- They will also learn how about how we can understand the author's perspective.

Science

Year 6 will have a focus on biology and the classification systems of living things. We will also have an introduction to micro-organisms. There will be a week- long immersion into university life and study focusing on journalism. Please see the link below
