



Message from the Associate Headteacher

Dear Parents and Carers,

Last week in our celebration assembly I spoke to children about the positive choices they make with their behaviour at ARK Bentworth and how we recognise these choices in our school. Children are working hard to collect 40 positive choices for their final certificates of the school year so please talk to your child about the kind of choices they are making in class to help get extra ticks or stamps. Each class has a behaviour tracker where teachers are able to move children's names up and down depending on the positive and negative choices they are making. We believe in starting every day a fresh so each child has their name on the centre of the chart and can have their name moved on to the bronze, silver or gold section if they make a positive choice. All these choices are then recorded at the end of the day.

If a child makes a choice that is not positive they will be given a verbal warning. And if they continue to make the wrong choice they may receive a yellow or red card depending on the severity of the incident. All these negative choices are recorded so the school can monitor children's behaviour and contact you if we feel it is necessary.

Thank you for supporting us and talking to your children about what appropriate behaviour looks like. We look forward to welcoming more of you to our celebration assemblies in the next few weeks as children receive certificates for all their fantastic positive choices!

As the hot weather continues please help your child to be ready for learning by providing them with a water bottle (no juice) to be drunk from through out their lessons. All children have access to water whilst they eat their lunch and can use the water fountains when they're outside in the playground. A reminder also that boys should be wearing grey socks and girls should be wearing white socks as part of their summer uniform and no coloured t-shirts worn as vests please.

Last night, the World Cup 2014 started in Brazil providing the perfect opportunity for plenty of discussion and debate about the games and the players.

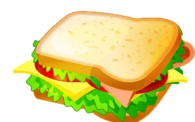
Question of the Week
