Dear Parents and Carers,

What an incredibly exciting week we have had.

On Tuesday the staff put on a wonderful sports day event. Well done to everyone who took part; the pupils, parents and staff. I've had lots of really positive comments from parents who enjoyed the day (*not spoilt at all by someone in shirt and shoes forgetting to stop at the finish line – obviously I will mention no names*)

On Wednesday our Year 6 pupils travelled to City of London Boys school with friends and family for their graduation ceremony. I think a quote from a parent says it best;

“I have never been so proud of them. They have worked so hard this year and look so grown up.”

And we are **extremely** proud of them. The Key Stage 2 SATs results this year have been better than any one could have predicted.

- 92% of pupils scored a level 4 or higher in reading (Level 4 is the expected level at end of KS2)
- 85% of pupils scored a level 4 or more in reading and mathematics.

It is the first time that the school has had results above National average scores in reading, writing and mathematics.

Well done to year 6 and their teachers. These are fantastic results.
