## Writing

In today's writing we are going to start thinking about the language we need when we are giving and writing instructions.

### What do mammals have in common?

We will continue to learn about mammals in today's lesson. We have identified the key characteristics of mammals and today we will be comparing two mammals of your choice.

All mammals are vertebrates — they have a spine or backbone

All mammals give birth to live young and feed their young with milk



All mammals have fur or hair



All humans are mammals

Mammal 1:         Dolphin              Mammal 2:         Elephant        


**What is similar about these mammals?**

The Elephant and the Dolphin both give birth to live young and feed them with milk.

Both mammals are grey, and their young is called a Calf.

**What is different about these mammals?**

One difference between a Dolphin and an Elephant is that the Elephant lives on land and the Dolphin lives in the ocean. An Elephant has four legs but a Dolphin has fins to help them to move in the water.

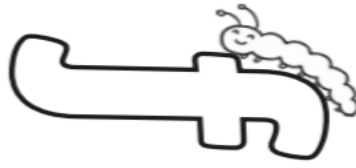
