Home Learning Activities

Reading	Listen to our stories on You Tube together. Talk about the stories and recall what happened afterwards. Have some fun and act out the stories together.				
Phonics	Begin to sound out phonic letters with your child.				
Topic	<p>Literacy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When reading a story move your finger along the words from left to right and point out letters in your child's name. • Continue to help your child write their names forming the letters correctly. <p>Maths:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk about the different size food your child eats. Point out the biggest or smallest food. • Compare different size clothes e.g who wears the biggest clothes in the family. <p>Understanding of the World:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Point out and name the different vegetables you see in the supermarket. • Recall visits to the doctors and talk about how they make us better. <p>Expressive Arts and Design:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a picture of your favourite vegetable and bring it into school to show us. • Make some cakes using playdough. <p>PSHE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage your child to draw a picture for a friend to make them happy. • Play a game together.

Nursery Curriculum Map

Summer 1

Literacy	Using props to help retell the stories we are learning about. Acting out the stories. Sequencing the stories into the correct order. To talk about our favourite stories and characters. Writing our names working on forming the letters correctly. To make marks as part of play.
Core Texts	Topsy and Tim go to hospital The Enormous Turnip Hooray for Hats by Brain Won Kind by Axel Scheffler The Smartest Giant by Julia Donaldson The Little Red Hen
Phonics	Continuing to learn our phonic sounds. Beginning to use Fred Talk to sound out our words.
Maths	To use number names when playing games together. To act out exchange of money or objects when in role play. To weigh vegetables and talk about size and compare quantities.
Understanding the World	To act out role play emergencies and learn that different people have different roles. To learn how to grow different vegetables and care for them.
Art and Expressive Design	To make sculptures using clay. To create their own stories and shows. To reflect on their own work and make changes.
PSED	To help a friend. To show an awareness of the feelings of others.
RE	Which stories are special and why?
PE	To learn to hold tools with more control. To learn about basic hygiene practices To practise dressing themselves.
Music	Listening and joining in with Nursery Rhymes. Learning new songs related to the topic.

Make a hat for someone to make them happy.


Make some bread




Find a recipe to make some bread. What ingredients do you need?


