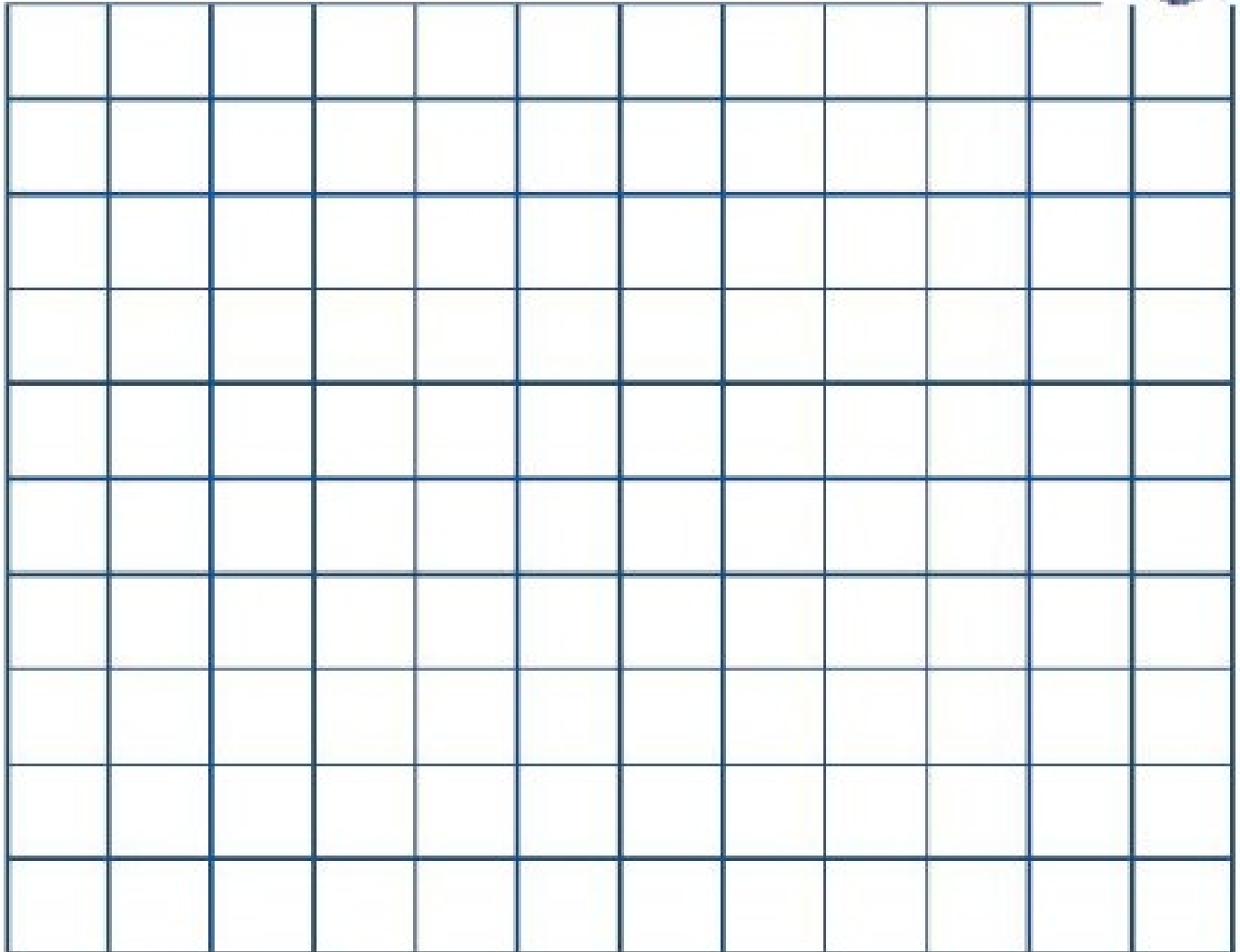

Writing

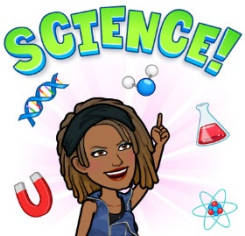
This week we have been writing poetry.

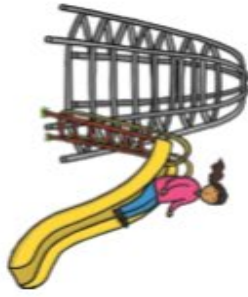
