Did he share equally? How do you know?

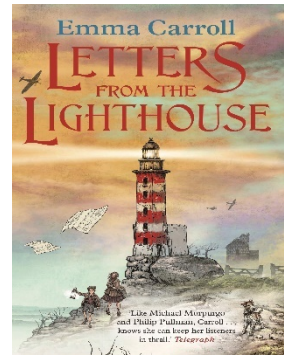
### Question 5

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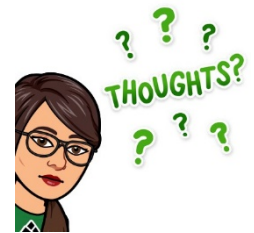
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This is the Second World War from a regular person's point of view, here is the Second World War from the point of view of a soldier.
